



The Rahmatulil Alameen Trust (Mercy 2 The Worlds) is a non-profit organization. The trust was founded in 1992 by a respected scholar and thinker Shahibzada Abu Tahir Muhammad Naqshband RA from Pakpattan, Pakistan. His vision was based upon a philosophy of 'Mercy' (rahmah) towards mankind. He believed that every human has a right (regardless of their faith, race, ethnicity, age, and ability) to receive the basic needs in life (education, health care, personal welfare, etc)

The Trust focuses on the provision of services in the three key areas: Health, Education, and Social Welfare of the most disadvantaged and vulnerable people. Starting from a very humble grassroots, the Trust has steadily grown and over the years has responded to countless emergencies, as well as establishing long-term projects such as Tayyiba School for Boys & Girls, Dress Making & Designing School for Women, Mobile Healthcare Clinics, and Trust Eye Hospital.

The Trust is managed by a board of trustees; many of whom grew up in the region and have retired from their profession. I am pleased to present the annual report which highlights the brilliant work in the areas of health, education and social welfare of the trust. This report celebrates the outstanding work we have done together.
